

The Kangaroo Care Project

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
Background

Kangaroo Care / skin to skin (S2S) rates noted to be decreased in the tiny baby population. Through a larger provincial project, it was determined that there was room for improvement with S2S.

Importance

S2S is when a baby, dressed only in a diaper, is positioned skin-to-skin against the bare chest of a parent. The practice is a lovely, natural way for parents to spend time with their baby. For premature infants, the practice is important for more than just bonding, as it is a way to ensure the baby's brain continues to grow and mature in a way similar to how it would develop in the womb.


Driver Diagram and Change Plan






Pre – implementation Data
